Nobumoto Tanahashi Undergraduate Scholarship

(Up to \$5,000 is available and will be applied to Fall 2017 tuition.)

*Full-time Undergraduate students from
University of Hawai'i at Mānoa may apply.*

This award was established in memory of Reverend Nobumoto Tanahashi (1906-1996), founder of the Heiwa Kyokai (Order of Peace Congregation), a school of Shintoism that is committed to peace. The Reverend Tanahashi was an independent Japanese businessman who made the cause of world peace his personal mission.

Eligibility for Scholarship

- A declared major in peace studies or conflict resolution
- Academic achievement as reflected in the student's grade point average
- Interest in and commitment to peace studies or conflict resolution as reflected in a one page statement written by the student

Evaluation Criteria

The Committee will evaluate each applicant's ability to implement or document his/her proposal or project to show interest in and commitment to peace studies or conflict resolution. If no suitable applications are received, no awards will be made.

- Unofficial transcript of academic record
- Proof of current full-time enrollment at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa
- One page essay describing commitment to peacemaking leadership, peace studies, or conflict resolution
- Letter of recommendation from an instructor or peace advocate with whom you have been closely associated
