Luncheon forum featuring Angelito A. Nayan, Assistant Director for the United States Division of the Office of American Affairs, Department of Foreign Affairs, Philippines

In October 2004, Angelito Nayan was taken hostage by militants in Afghanistan where he served as a United Nations Professional Training Officer. During this talk, Nayan will share his personal and life changing experiences as well as an assessment of the current issues facing the region.

Nayan was awarded in November 2004 by President-elect Hamid Karzai the Sayed Jamaluddin Afghan Medal (Afghanistan's second highest Medal of Honor, named after the 19th Century Islamic Scholar) for his involvement in the landmark electoral process in Afghanistan.

Nayan is visiting the United States under the auspices of the U.S. State Department International Visitor Leadership Program. He was selected to participate in a delegation from the Philippines to learn more about U.S. Foreign Policy as it relates to Counter-terrorism and Human Rights.

"I hope to share with the participants not only my experience in Afghanistan but also how this incredible journey strengthened my resolve to continue my personal advocacy for peace and my professional commitment to work in the Philippine Foreign Service."
