Using Stafford's poetry and prose, the film invites viewers to reflect on their own ideas regarding war and how individual witnesses can contribute to a more peaceful world. The film features an array of writers and activists including Coleman Barks, Robert Bly, Maxine Hong Kingston, Michael Meade, W.S. Merwin, Naomi Shihab Nye, Kim Stafford, and Alice Walker.

The post-film discussion between Director Haydn Reiss and Associate Professor of Peace Studies Brien Hallett will address the cinematography and portrayal of the subject, and the use of the aesthetic to communicate with viewers.
